The Buddy System is designed to look out for our neighbors.

During office hours, office personnel will respond. If the office is closed, please follow these simple steps:

- Knock on the neighbors door with the illuminated light on the wall.
- If no one answers call 911.
- Smoke Detector—the alarm will stop sounding when the smoke clears.

Pull Cord-To turn off the alarm on the pull cord, push up on the small black switch near the cord.

Remember, in the case of an emergency, always call 911!

Building Safety:

Attention Pet Owners:

Reminder, all dogs MUST utilize the dog run that is on the South side of LMI, along the canal.
